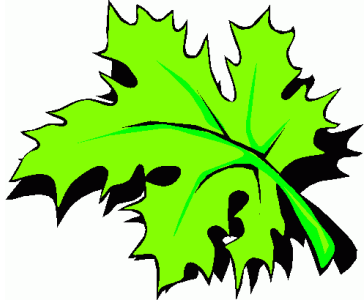
Dear Families of our JK/SK class,
